## FAQs

### **What is GiveLife?**

GiveLife is a challenge amongst churches to increase the number of registered African American organ and tissue donors. The goal is for each participating church to gain registered organ and tissue donors and help save lives. The challenge is July 28-September 1.

### **Why is it important to increase the number of registered donors in the African American community?**

African Americans are one of the smallest groups to register as organ and tissue donors; however, there are more than 4,000 Mid-Southerners awaiting an organ transplant, 2,000 of which are African Americans awaiting kidneys.

### **How can my church participate in GiveLife?**

Your church can participate by encouraging congregation members who are not already organ and tissue donors to register at [midsouthtransplant.org/givelife](https://midsouthtransplant.org/givelife). Registrants will enter their name and the name of their church.

### **What are some ways I can encourage my church to participate?**

While we are thankful for and appreciate your congregation's previously registered donors, the GiveLife campaign is for newly registered donors only.
